

# NEW YEAR CAR CARE CHECKLIST

## Tire Inspection & Pressure Reset

## Battery Health Check

- If your battery is 3 years or older, a quick test can prevent unexpected winter stalls.

## Brake Inspection

- If your brake pedal feels soft, squeaky, or less responsive, it's worth getting an inspection before winter weather gets tougher.

## Wiper Blade & Visibility Check

- Replace worn or streaky blades. Ensure headlights, brake lights, and turn signals are bright and functioning.

## Oil & Fluid Top-Off

- Replace old oil and ensure all fluids (coolant, brake, power steering, and washer) are at proper levels.

## Alignment & Suspension Check

- Inspect for signs of misalignment caused by winter potholes or rough roads.

## Cabin Air Filter Refresh

- A clean cabin air filter helps prevent foggy windows and keeps your heating system running efficiently.

## Heating & Defrost System Test

- Make sure your heater, defroster, and rear window defogger are working properly to keep visibility clear.

## Tire Tread Depth Check

- If your tread looks low or worn, it may be time to replace your tires for safer stopping and better grip on icy roads.

## Emergency Kit

- Restock your winter essentials: gloves, flashlight, ice scraper, and jumper cables to stay prepared for unexpected situations.
